PERSONNEL NARRATIVE FOR PATROL OFFICER KYLE A CONNORS

On Wednesday, 2/12/2020, at approximately 1441, I was dispatched to the front lobby to speak with Douglas Davidson Douglas wanted to report a theft that occured in the area of 239 Broad St. Douglas mentioned that he is the chair of the Hollis republicans and had been advertising his signs in the yard of 239 Broad St. with permission from the owner and the town. Douglas says that as he was driving by to collect his signs, he noticed another individual loading his signs into the back of a truck.

Douglas spoke with the individual and recognized him to be Thomas Harris DOB Douglas told Thomas that the signs belonged to him and that Thomas had no right to remove the signs. Douglas wanted to point out that Thomas Harris is a rival democrat. Douglas is very unhappy and is seeking charges both criminal and civil.

On Friday, 2/14/2020 at approximately 0900, I went to the residence of Thomas Harris, located at 1 Broad St. and spoke to Thomas. I asked Thomas to explain his side of what happened during his interaction with Douglas and what his intentions were when he was removing the signs. Thomas told me that he simply goes out after elections and removes signs that belong to him and other signs that he does not recognize. Thomas did not recognize the signs he was taking as they simply say "walk away" with no visible political party attached to it. Douglas's name and party affiliation was located at the very bottom of the sign in small fine print however, Thomas told me that as he is an older gentlemen, his eyes are not good enough to have read that. Thomas did not intend to steal or deprive Douglas of his signs and was apologetic of the confusion. On 2/178/2020 at 0705, I called and spoke with Douglas to notify him that no criminal charges were going to be pressed against Thomas Harris. Due to both parties statements, I recommend this case be closed.
